### **Benefit Explanation Sheet**

#### **Renewable energy and energy efficiency product and service discounts:**

- ❑ Solar Works – free site visit valued at \$125 and 5% off product and installation
- ❑ Apricus Solar System – 15% off product
- ❑ Rands Hardware – 10% off energy efficiency products and plumbing parts for a solar system.

#### **Energy Assessment and Planning Sessions:**

- ❑ As a member you have the opportunity to schedule an Energy Assessment and Planning Session at your home/business with a staff or mentor of the Initiative to formulate an energy plan. This plan will help you identify steps toward energy reduction and efficiency. You will be given information and ideas that will help you further your goals. Travel Restrictions May Apply.

#### **Initial Renewable Energy Site Visit:**

- ❑ The purpose of the visit is to discuss the viability and/or most logical renewable energy system for your site. This visit is recommended as the first step for people contemplating installing a renewable energy system. Travel Restrictions May Apply.

#### **Guidance on Individualized Energy Plans:**

- ❑ The Initiative will provide you with contacts and resources to aid in the completion of your energy plan.

#### **Networking and Mentoring Opportunities:**

- ❑ Some current members of the Initiative have agreed to share their experience and acquired knowledge with others seeking to do energy efficiency upgrades and renewable energy installations. The Initiative will work with you to set up meetings with these mentors. Every member has the opportunity to become a mentor once they have installed a system of their own or have a certain knowledge area they are willing to share.

#### **Access to and/or Discounts at Training Seminars and Educational Workshops:**

- ❑ Training sessions for homeowners and tradespeople on such things as solar thermal applications and installations will be organized by the Initiative.
- ❑ Free Educational Workshops will be provided on such things as Energy Basics, Netmetering and Energy Efficiency Products.
- ❑ Tours of existing solar installations in the area can be scheduled up request at anytime.

#### **Energy Raisers and Energy Exchanges:**

- ❑ Energy Exchanges – a gathering of members will be scheduled regularly for inspiration, networking and resource sharing. These will be announced in the Membership Updates.
- ❑ Energy Raisers – Modeled after community barn raisers, Energy Raisers are productive, hands on educational events that take place on the day of a member's solar installation. Travel restrictions may apply.

#### **Access to the Energy Initiative's Resource Library:**

- ❑ Members can borrow books, materials and specialized tools from the Initiative.
